



MID-CAB WINDOW UPDATE

OVERVIEW

The Sales Department would like to inform the dealer network there has been a design change for the mid-cab window. All chassis built after HS-6155 will be installed with the new Hehr International clamp-in window. The window style is very similar to the windows that are installed in the rear wall, and should eliminate the corrosion we see so frequently in the mid-cab window area.

MID-CAB WINDOW UPDATE

OVERVIEW

With this updated design we would like to inform you that the current bracket that the battery charge indicator sits on no longer fits, and hits the window frame. There are multiple options if you wish to not have the display in the window. One new option would be to upgrade to Kussmaul's new built-in battery charge indicator as seen below.

The second option would be to mount the display in the drivers seat riser. Which has been accomplished multiple times in the past.



The last option would be to still have it mounted in the window with a new bracket that mounts it higher, and a little further back from its current position. All of these options will not add any additional cost to the current trucks. We simply wanted to inform the dealer network of the options available moving forward. The Sales Team will continue to work hard to notify the dealer network on any changes or updates in the future.
