This new coating is designed to be easy to apply and offers a smoother and glossier finish. This coating does not contain NMP solvent and meets VOC standards for multicolor. This will be the new standard process moving forward.

Benefits:

- Has a smoother finish than 90 Series.
- Has a glossier angular sheen than 90 Series.
- Has a higher performance exterior finish with superior durability and chemical resistance.
- It now contain nalzin. Which is a flash rust inhibitor providing both long term
 protection and stability. Which is the same inhibitor used on The Golden Gate
 Bridge and The Bay Area bridge to name a couple famous structures.
- It also has better finishing results which makes it easier to clean.

Testing:

- Accelerated Weathering (ASTM D-4587): A Bulb 8hrs Light / 60C + 4hrs condensation / 50C. No film failure and moderate calking 75,500 hrs. No film failure and slight chalking @ 3,000hrs.
- Abrasive Resistance (ASTM D-4060): Taber abrasion 149mg loss. 1,000 cycles CS-17 wheels 500 gram load.
- Impact Resistance (ASTM D-2794): Passed 72psi.
