STB-0100 - Clean Idle Sticker Placement

<u>OVERVIEW</u>

To remain compliant with federal regulations, Sutphen has begun placing clean idle stickers on our Monarch Extreme-Duty chassis.

The clean idle sticker will be placed slightly past the J-Channel and edge of the bumper on the driver's side. It will align with the Monarch Extreme Duty Chassis sticker also on the cab.

You can see a picture of this primary placement below:



In the instance of a bumper with an extended wrap, the sticker will be placed directly above the bumper on the driver's side.

OVERVIEW

If both the primary and secondary placement locations are unavailable due to bumper wrap, graphics or other extenuating circumstances, we will adjust accordingly.

Please be aware that this sticker is a federal requirement, and it should not be removed by the dealership, customer or operator of the vehicle. Each label is serialized, and it is directly linked to the engine serialization. If the label is removed or damaged, it must be replaced.

You can expect to see this sticker on all trucks moving forward.
