STB-0103 –Bostrom Seat Replacement Recommendations After Airbag Deployment

OVERVIEW

It has been brought to our attention there has been some confusion on wreck repairs in reference to Bostrom Seats.

Please find the letter below, also attached to the email, from Bostrom telling us when the air bag seats need to be replaced after a wreck. These seat repairs apply to all dealers.

If there is a wreck – all seats do not need to be changed if they are thoroughly inspected – confirm that the seat belts are working properly, the structure of the cab intact and all bolts are tight that hold the seat in. You will need to inspect the seat frame, headrest, and if it is an electric seat or air seat – make sure they are working properly, it is not mandatory to change the non-air bag seats unless damage has occurred.

In order to replace the seats, please call the Sutphen Parts Division and work with Morgan Fox to purchase replacement seats that are specifically made with our design for Sutphen.
